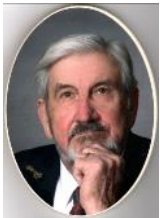

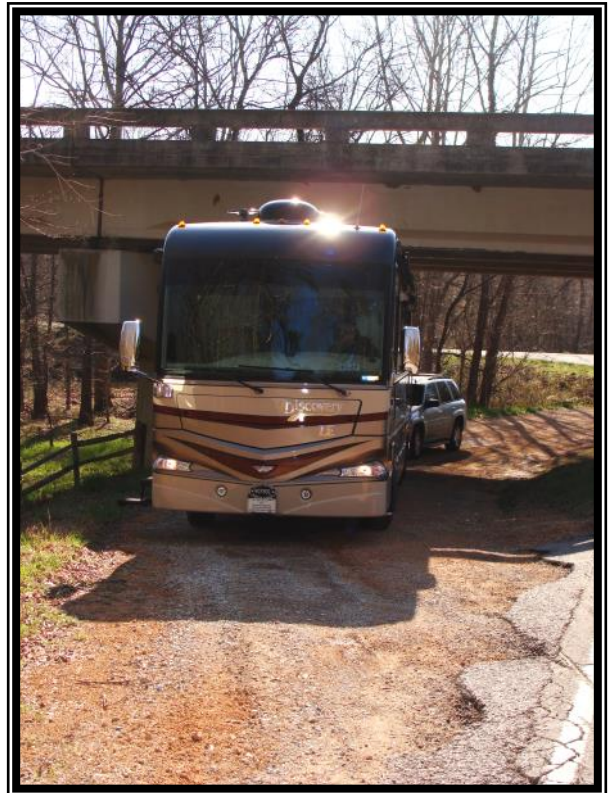

GPS BEWARE

A word of warning about the use of GPS's with the RV. I have a Rand McNally Model 5510 which is designed for RV's and truckers. It allows you to enter your vehicle height, width, & weight. Once entered the GPS is "**supposed**" to ensure that the route planned by the software will not put you in violation of these parameters. I say "**supposed**" to because at times it will have you turn where there is no turn, either because the software hasn't been upgraded for new roads, etc., "or" changes that have not been mapped yet. While travelling to a Thousand Trails/KOA RV park last month in Hohenwald, TN, the GPS routed me down the Natchez Trace. Now this is a two lane highway but has no stop lights or stop signs from beginning to end and a 55 mph speed limit. The problem came when the GPS told me to turn left off the Trace. Where I was supposed to turn left there was no turn even though I could see the road I needed to be on below as I crossed over an overpass. About 100 yards further up there was a right turn which I took. As I came around the exit onto the road I saw the sign at the same time that my GPS went crazy with the "height warning". Folks a 12 foot 10 inch motorhome will not clear an 11 foot bridge. Since I was only going 5 mph I had no trouble stopping. Now the decision to unhook the tow, back up, reconnect, and continue to an alternate route (for which there was none). At this time a "local" pulling a stump grinder (fellow stump grinder) stopped and asked if I needed some help. As I explained the process I was about to undertake he said no just go off the road on the left side in the gravel median since it was two feet lower than the actual paved road. I was skeptical to be sure but he assured me that he would watch and make sure I cleared. He said tractor trailers use this route every day. True to his word he stood on the road level and motioned me through. Sure enough he was right. I cleared with 6 inches to spare. Needless to say Glenda was on pins and needles as I passed under the bridge. My point is that some of the older GPS units do not give you the option to enter your parameters and this could spell trouble for you in a case like this. When I got to the campground I told them that "their" bridge sucked, pardon my French! They said yes they had been trying to get the State or County to do something about it for several years but budgets prevent anything from happening. She said that the previous week a guy came down that road with a brand new fifth wheel camper and stripped his A/C's right off the top. I am sure Glenda will put the pictures of "our" bridge with this so you can see what we faced. So if you go off the beaten path of interstate highways beware! (Courtesy of Bob Angus)

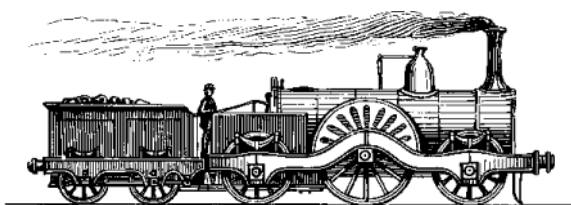
Members were quick to respond. Take note of these replies as they may come in handy should you experience problems.

FOR THE COOK



EASY BIG FAT YEAST ROLLS

- 1 Cup warm water
- 1 Pkg active dry yeast
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 1 Tsp salt
- 3 Tbls softened butter
- 1 Egg, beaten
- 3 1/2 - 4 cups flour



Put water and yeast in large mixing bowl and add next 4 ingredients. Beat with dough hook until well blended. Add 3 1/2 to 4 cups flour and mix until soft dough forms (should not be sticky). Put out onto floured board and knead a few times until smooth. Place in greased bowl, cover with plastic wrap and let rise in warm place approx. 45 minutes. Punch down and turn out onto floured board. Shape into 12 rolls and place in greased 13x9 in. baking pan. Let rise again about 30 minutes. Bake 350° for 20 minutes. Brush tops of rolls with butter. Recipe is easily doubled. (Bob Angus)

- 1 Cup unsweetened Pineapple Juice, chilled
- 1 Cup Orange Juice, chilled
- 1/4 Cup Lemon Juice, chilled
- 1 Quart unsweetened Apple Juice, chilled

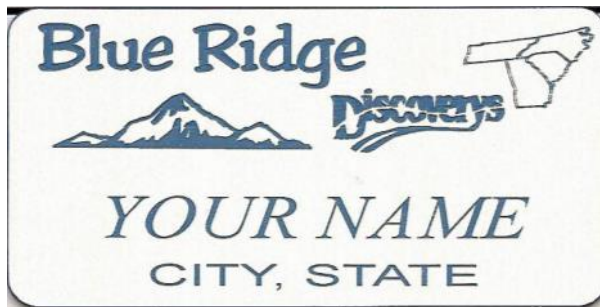
