MAINTENANCE

As we get older our eyesight gets a little fuzzy, our limbs get a little stiffer and other parts may stop working altogether! Our resident Discovery repair technician (Frank Cason) and I were discussing fuses several months ago. He stated that he had started replacing all of his fuses with the kind that light up when they blow. I got to thinking about all of those fuse panels that Fleetwood fills our coaches with and the various locations. Have you noticed that you sometimes have to stand on your head to read the fuse location and lay down just to reach some of them? Well I did so I decided that I would also change out all of mine too. Consider being on the side of the road, at night, in the dark with a blown fuse. Wouldn't it be nice to take the cover off and immediately know which fuse you need to replace? Now that is reality on my Discovery. But I found out something even more interesting. Seems I have a solar panel that has never worked since I bought my 2012 in Nov of 2011. While replacing the fuses I noticed a 10A fuse in a spot that was marked 5A on the cover. I replaced it with a 5A and it immediately blew. I tried a 10A and it blew also. So last week while I was in Decatur with some other issues I had Fleetwood check that circuit. Seems when they built it the technician crossed the power wires on the control panel during installation. When he put the fuse in it blew so he put a bigger one in. When it blew he just left it for the dealer or new owner to solve. Since we don't do any dry camping had I not changed out the fuses I would never have known this problem existed. So much for Fleetwood quality control huh?? Anyway if you are interested in changing out your fuses you can find them in a 30 piece set (both the standard and mini fuses) at the Harbor Tools store in your area. Part # 67693 for the standard and # 67694 for the mini's. Both run \$8.99 for the thirty piece set. You may have to get two depending on how many of each type you need. The only ones they don't have are the 3A fuse which I got from Del City Part # 88833 for the standard and #77403 for the mini. I can't remember how many I needed but I think they were priced less than a dollar a piece. Hope this helps!

Just outside of the Marine Corps Base at Quantico, VA is the Marine Corps Museum. It is not on the base, and it's close to I-95, so it is easy to get to. It has a fabulous display of Marine Corps history and life in the Marines. Well worth the visit. The highlight of our visit was meeting a Marine veteran from the battle of Iwo Jima. He carried a flame thrower and was the only survivor of his 26 man platoon. What an inspiring warrior!

Savannah, Georgia

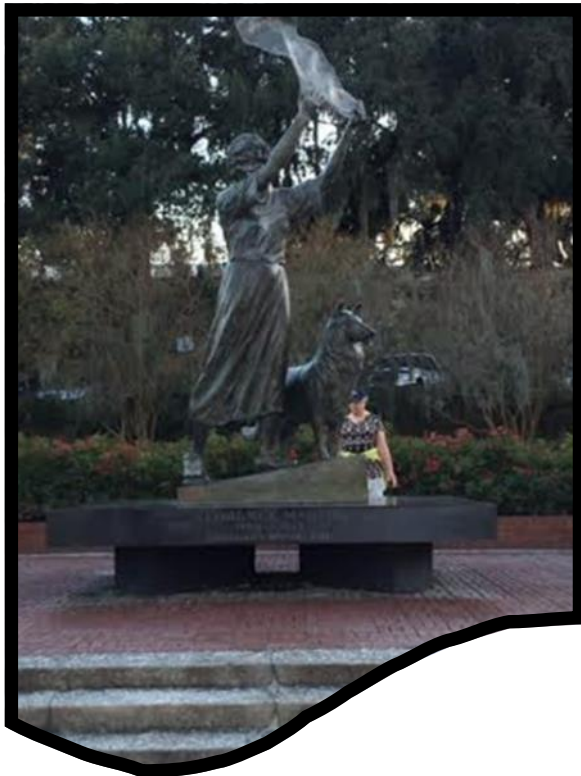

We parked the RV at Skidaway State Park, which is very convenient to the city and nearby Tybee Island. They have many large sites with 50 amp service. While there we took advantage of their cheap bicycle rentals and explored the parks shady trails.

The timing of our trip was to visit the Taste of Savannah, a wine and food fest held downtown. It was a fun time with some great culinary samples. Our admission included several tokens that are used to purchase the food. The many wines, beers, and liquors were free! I would return to this fest if the opportunity was there.

Savannah offers many activities. On our first evening we went on a walking ghost tour. The guide tried to make it interesting, but unless you're into ghosts, I think you'd be as disappointed as we were. However, the walk along River Street with its many shops, restaurants, and bars was exceptional. We dined at Hueys and would recommend it, but there is no shortage of good places to eat.

Savannah was laid out in sections and is full of small squares. This one had a memorial to the Civil War

One of the places the guide recommended was a visit to the synagogue. It was built to match the rest of the city and really looks like an old Christian church. They offer tours and we got to learn about the early Jewish settlers to Savannah. They have a small museum with some very interesting artifacts, including two very old Tora from the 1400's, a circumcision kit, a menorah and many other artifacts. We were glad he recommended this and the Catholic cathedral, Saint John the Baptist.

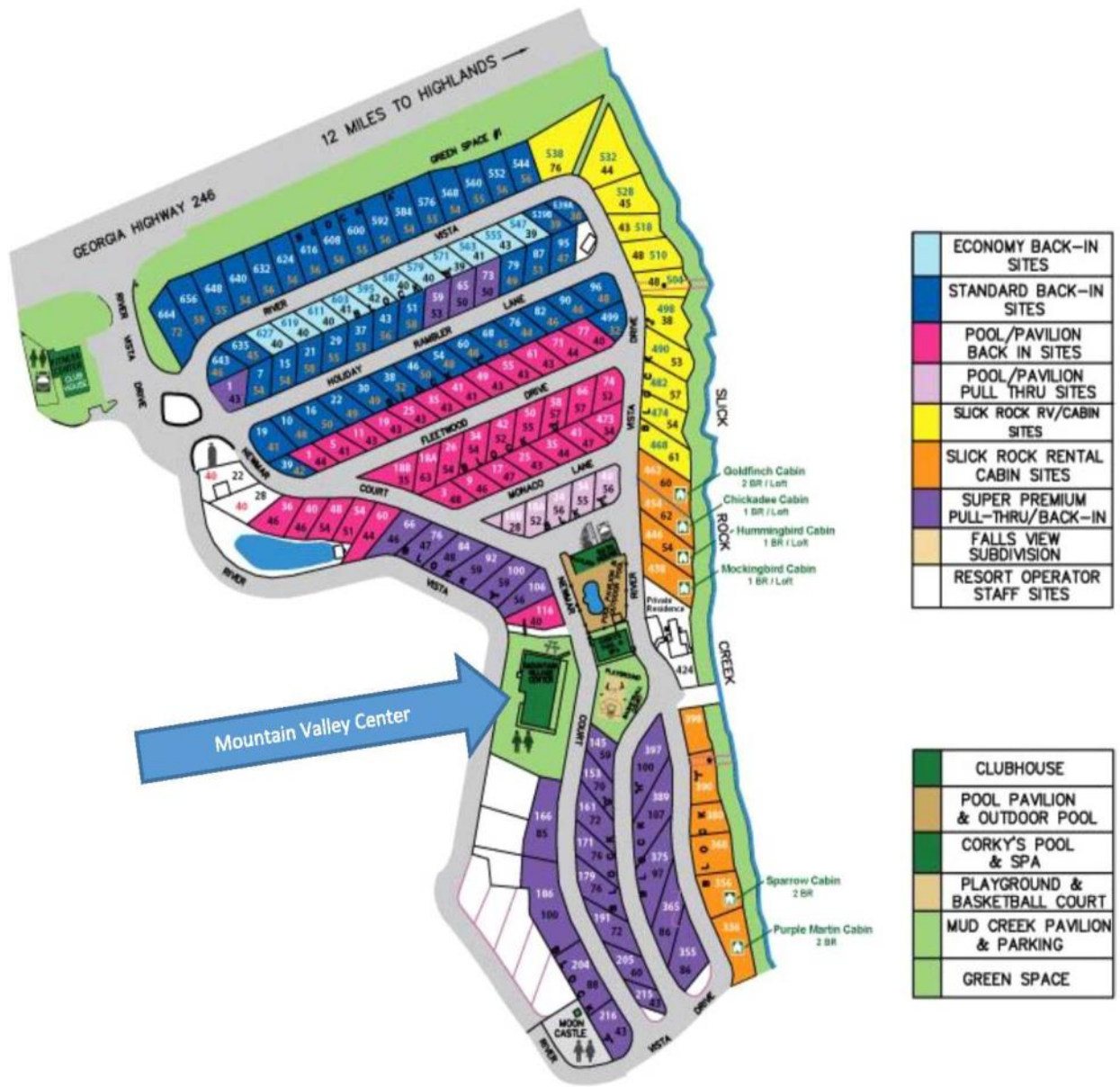

CRAB CHEESE BALL

- 2 8oz cream cheese, softened
- 1 can crab meat
- 1/4 cup chopped onion (I use green onions)
- 1/4 cup chopped green pepper
- 1 teaspoon lemon juice
- Dash Worcestershire
- Dash tobasco
- 1 cup chopped pecans



Mix all ingredients, except pecans. Form into ball. Let it sit in fridge overnight.

GRILLING TIPS

Perfect Hamburgers on a Grill

What's more American than grilling hamburgers? Hamburgers and hot dogs are the whole reason they put grills in public parks. Burgers and hot dogs are the entire reason we show up at the stadium 6 hours before the game (well, and beer I guess...). Like many other grilling recipes, people just need to slow down and pay attention to details and technique to achieve burger grilling deliciousness.

1. Choose the right meat. Newsflash, some fat tastes good! Try ground chuck or sirloin. Try about 20% fat.
2. Use high heat and cook them fast. Leave the lid open and don't cook too long or they will be dry.
3. Be gentle with the meat a loosely packed patty makes for a juicy hamburger!
4. Don't "squish" PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE don't ever flatten or squish the burgers with a spatula while they are grilling.
5. Flip only once and don't cook to long (about 20 mins). Time varies based on the grill and thickness of the hamburger.
6. Don't skimp on buns. Try French hamburger buns.
7. Limit seasoning. A little salt and fresh ground pepper and/or garlic powder are good.

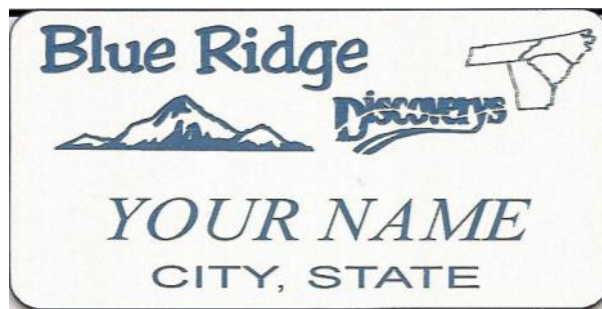
