PRESIDENT'S REPORT

This will be a short newsletter this month, not much to report on.

First thing to mention is the Mason-Dixon Rally in Frederick, MD. All that attended had a great time. We also have to mention that Dick and Sue Smith were presented with Life Membership into the Mason-Dixon Discoveries for all the work they have done and continue to do.

Next I need to speak about the 2010 Southeast Regional DOAI Rally. The Mason-Dixons will be the host for this rally. We need to determine a location, a theme, and dates. A theme has been suggested as "Camp Discovery" where we would have seminars on our Discoverys, on how to do our own maintenance and minor repairs. The seminars would be geared specifically for Discovery Motorhomes. It was also suggested to keep the rally very basic by having pot luck meals and little entertainment. This would keep the cost down quite a bit. We need input, so please let me hear from you.

Lastly, I wanted to mention an incident that occurred to Alice and my 2000 36T Discovery. After the DOAI National Rally in Indiana, Alice and I went to Niagara Falls, NY and then to New Bedford, MA. During our trip, we experienced some severe road construction and poorly maintained roads on I 90 in particular.

It is believed that the conditions caused serious damage to our coach. The brackets that hold the coach to the chassis broke. This caused the coach to just rest on the chassis, and not be secure. The brackets that broke are located just forward and rear of the rear axle. We knew we had a problem of some sort when our 'Low Air" alarm sounded and we were not losing air. We contacted Freightliner about the alarm and we were advised it would be OK to drive the coach to a repair facility in East Providence, RI. It was the mechanics at Altrui Brothers Freightliner that located this damage. We were told that this damage is rare, but it does occur. There is no maintenance for this, only visual inspections that can be done when checking your tire pressure. I have included a couple of photos of the damaged brackets to show what they look like.
